The SARC Web SDR is currently off line. We've been having a few problems and we're in the process of relocating it for further testing.

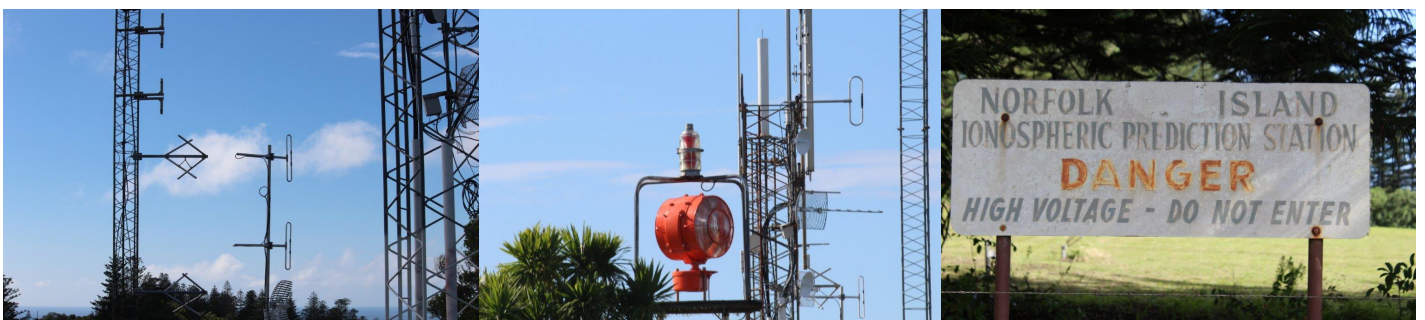
Parrot repeater off air.

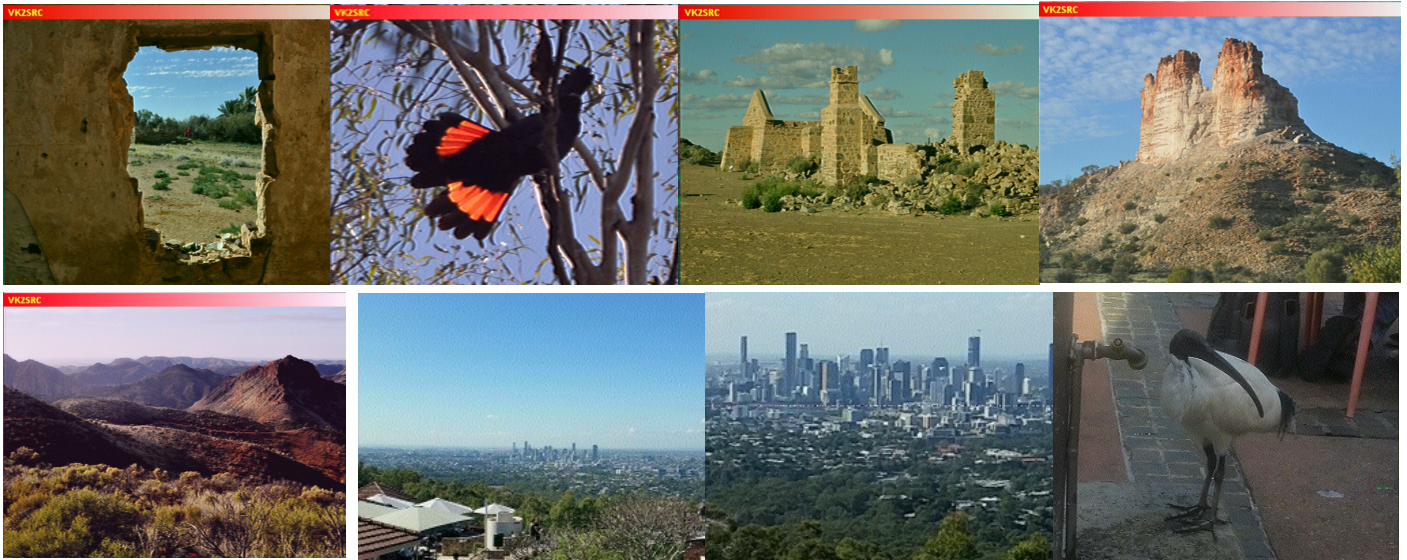
Monday 4 June, 2018

It was a bit disappointing to only have the two of us, but, nevertheless we went ahead. We hadn't tried the analogue image program MMSSTV and used it on PD120 and PD240 modes. Once again SSB proved its excellence on 2 metres, giving an almost FM like quality. The signal strength from Duncan was S3 at best but that didn't prevent the reception of perfect images, without slant or noise bars. My photos were all taken on an outback trip and Duncan used some photos from a Brisbane trip.

A very successful net again. I have to say that I cannot thank Duncan enough for his support for the digi net for without that it would have folded. The net finished at 9.45pm. The digi net lives, but not by much!
