On previous nets we had been using 2 metre USB but Dave didn't have that mode so we used FM through the Woodburn repeater, something we had not done for a while.

SRC started things off using MP140 mode, a mode that conveniently fits within the 3 minute repeater timeout. Once again MMSSTV proved its worth and relative ease of use. Images can be simply dragged and dropped onto the TX window and the program resizes it. Dave did need a couple of memory jogs but didn't take long to start transmitting.

Dave actually was the star of the show, transmitting slant free images that, quality wise, were the best on the night. Some real stunners and classic early pics of Lismore. Pretty good effort for someone who hadn't used MMSSTV for a while.

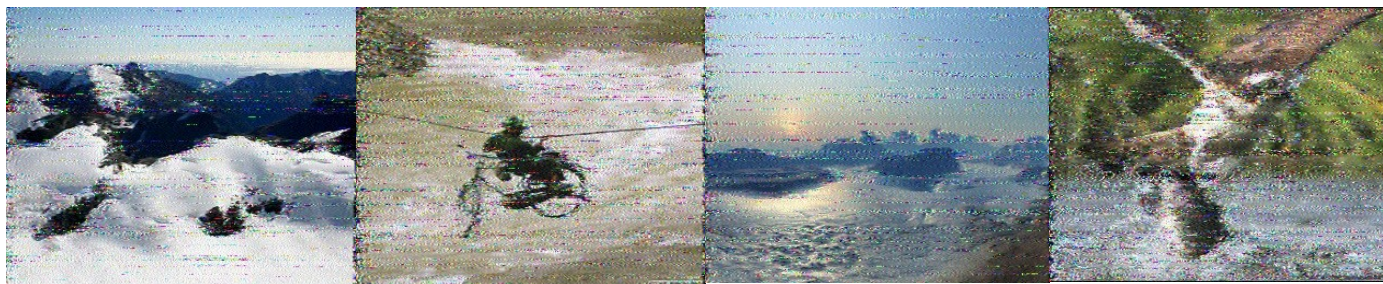
Pretty noisy to me where i am, but still decoded just fine...although lots of pixelation....hihi
