DIGITAL MODES:

Monday 16 April 2018


For tonight's net we had VK2PMG/SRC as net control with Leith VK2EA, Steve VK2SLM and Duncan VK2DLR logging in, so it was DLR and PMG-SRC transmitting digitally – Thee and Me – again. I suggested that we use Fl Digi and 2 metres USB on 145.1 mHz.

In spite of there being only the two of us, it was an excellent session with many interesting points being raised and topics discussed. One reason I keep returning to Fl Digi is that it is conversational. The modem we used was Thor 22, which is an ideal combination of robustness and speed. The forward error correction helps Thor combat noise and there were no missing or poorly decoded text. There is some more information on Thor here:

Thor can also transmit images using 11, 16 and 22 baud and we might just experiment with that and test its limits. The net finished at about 10pm and, once again, I must thank Duncan for his support and all those who logged in.

WIA Radio and Electronics Convention - Beyond 2020

SeaWorld - Gold Coast Queensland 18th, 19th and 20th of May 2018

The WIA Annual General Meeting (AGM) and Technical Forum will be held over the weekend of 18th, 19th and 20th May 2018 at SeaWorld on the Gold Coast.

This years event is being organised by the Gold Coast Amateur Radio Club (GCARC) with most of the weekends activities taking place at the Sea World Resort.

VK2SBP - "1st Chinderah" Amateur Radio

The VK2SBP radio room has had another addition over the weekend!

We've installed a Yaesu FTM-400D V/u Dualbander which is connected to a Diamond X-300 vertical antenna. The FTM-400D has been mounted alongside/above the existing Yaesu FT-8800R V/u Dualbander which we have connected to a Diamond X-50 vertical antenna.

The two V/u Dualband radios that are now installed will give VK2SBP the ability to monitor 4 x frequencies simultaneously or even more if we utilise the radio Scan function! During normal operations, VK2SBP will most likely be monitoring the 146.700 mhz VK4RGC 2m repeater at Springbrook (Gold Coast Qld) and the 438.675 mhz VK2RPL 70cm repeater at Mount Nardi (northern NSW). Another local asset we have available to us is a Simplex RF IRLP/Echolink Node operated by Steve VK2ARS from Terranora on 145.400 mhz. This frequency will most likely be monitored on a regular basis along with the others previously mentioned (145.400 mhz VK2ARS IRLP Node # 6255 / Echolink Node # 299433).
