DIGITAL MODES

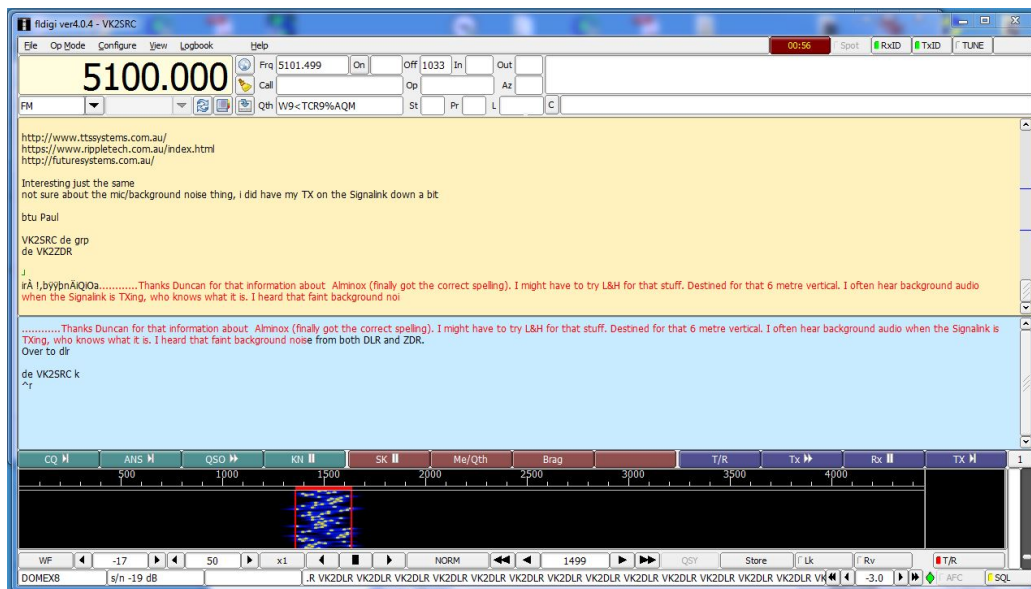
Monday 2 JULY 2019
