We used 80 metres, 3.570 USB. Most of us used a reasonable amount of power to keep up decoding accuracy, due to the noise levels. Olivia did its expected good job, with no decoding problems.

Rhod VK2TTL dropped in right at the end, during the "goodnight" round, as he was on another net that also started at 8pm. It was good to have him join us. There was some discussion about next week, with 40 metres being tried with MMSSTV. Chris had the good idea of starting off with Olivia to judge propagation. Another good net, thanks to all who logged in and participated.
