TUESDAY JANUARY 25, 2021

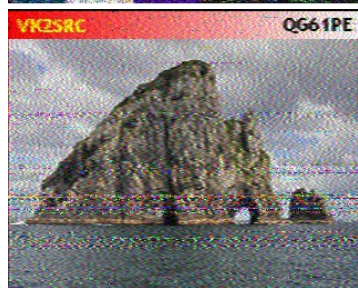
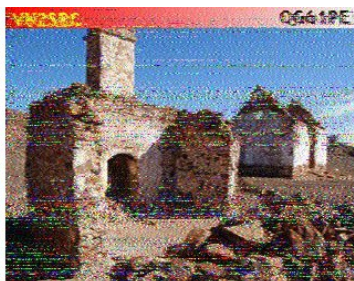
Logging in this evening were Duncan VK2DLR, Jeff VK2WSR, Chris VK2ACD, John VK2ZJJ and Dave VK2ZDR. We QSY'd to 20 metres for an experiment, starting off with Fldigi and Olivia 8-500 to test propagation. Local signals decoded well but Jeff's Fldigi decode was only about 40%.

We switched to MMSSTV Scottie 2 on the same frequency and again, local images were noisy but recognisable. Any images from Jeff were pretty poor so we switched to 40 metres, ending up on 7.036. The images I received were not good but Chris VK2ACD received them from Jeff well.

VK3FUR dropped in and exchanged a couple of images, so that was good. Conditions were definitely not as good as last week. An interesting experiment that showed that 20 metres may be good during the day but 80m and 40m are better in the evening.

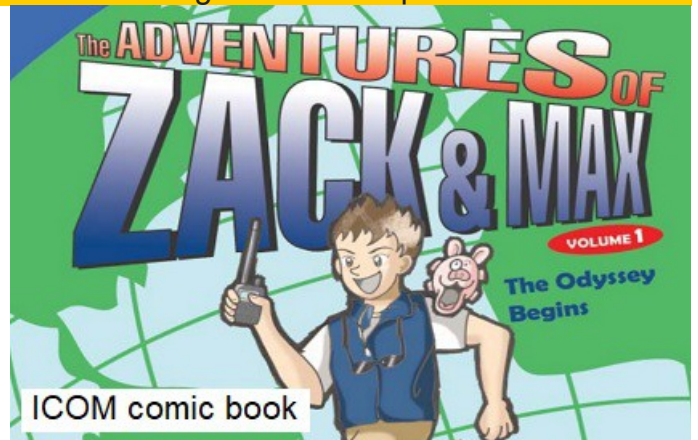

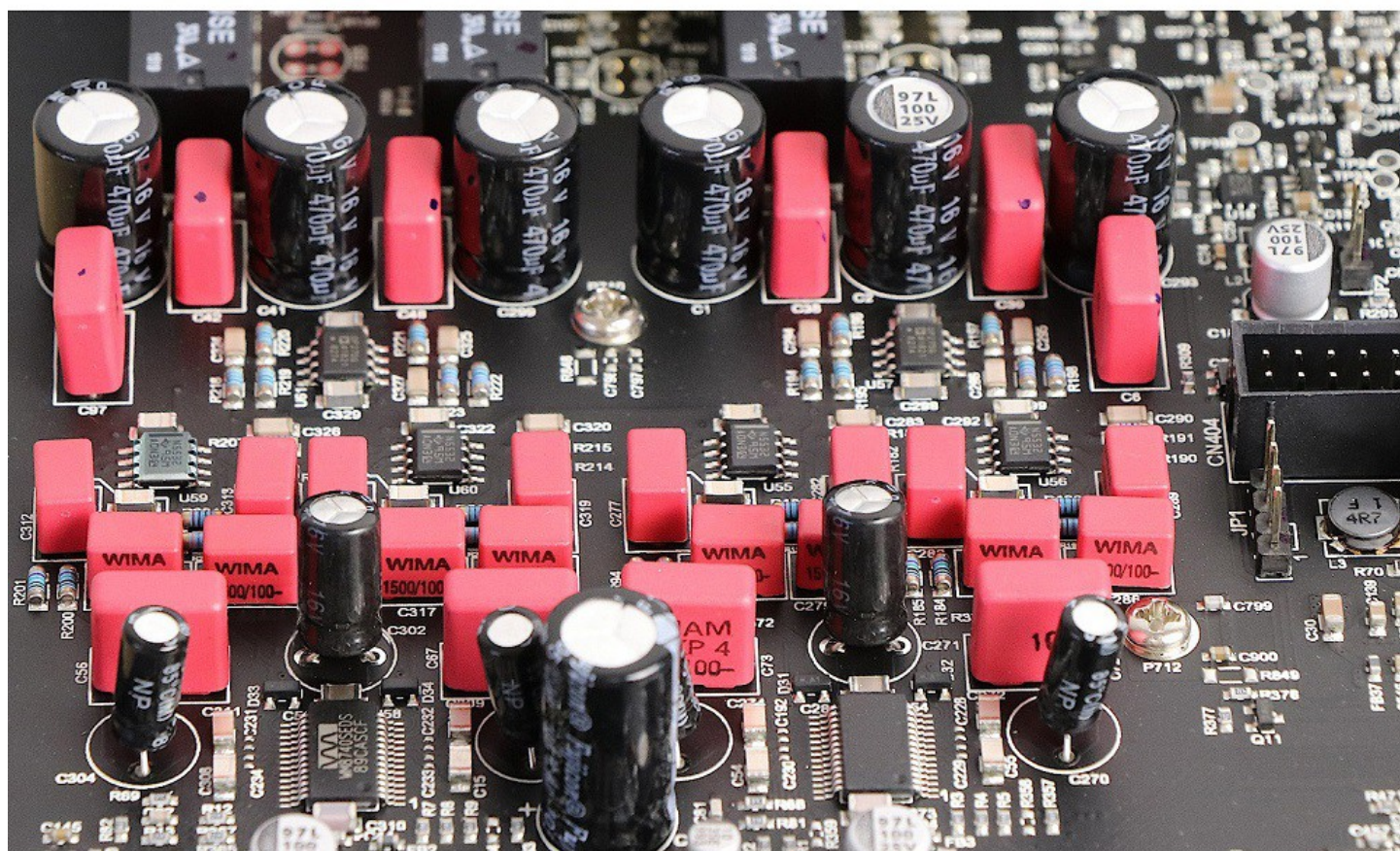
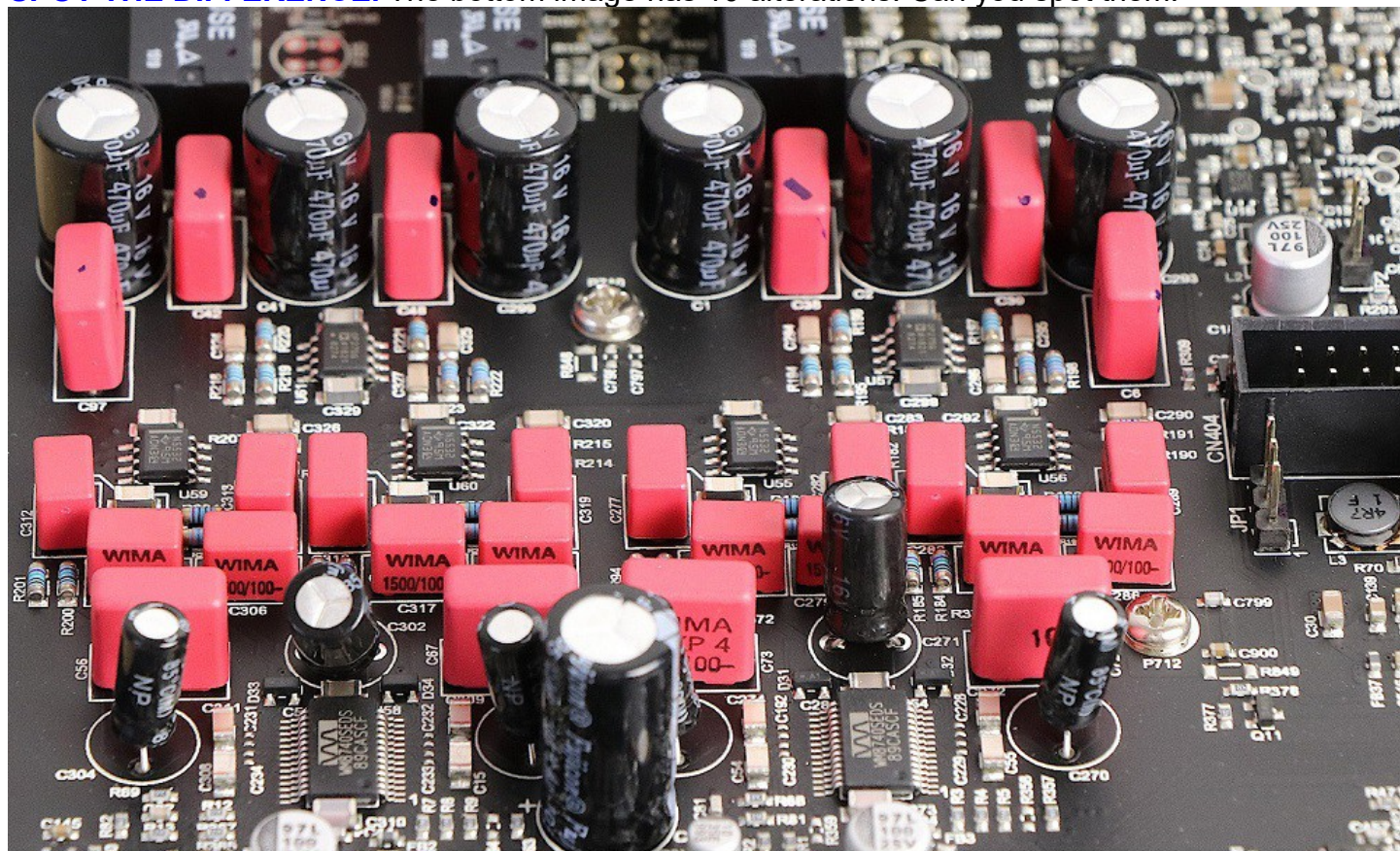
WANTED DEAD or ALIVE: HOPALONG CAPACITY!
