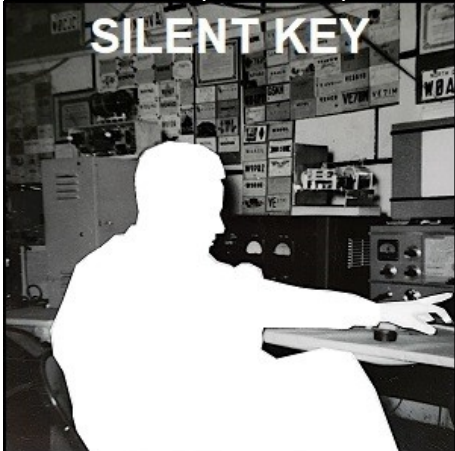

Bill Parker (VK2KDI) - SK - de Duncan VK2DLR



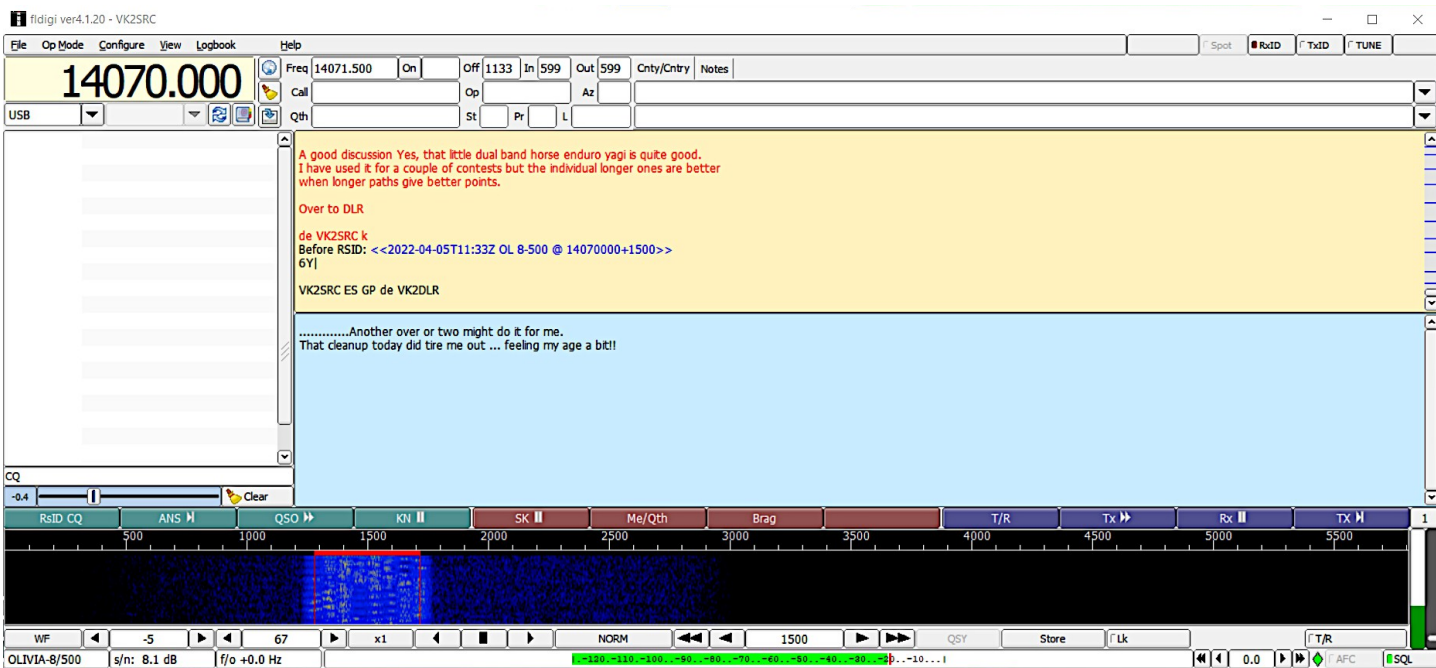
A recent enquiry into the welfare of past members has led to the discovery that former SARC member William James (Bill) Parker had passed away on the 7th of March at the age of 92. His service was held on the 17th. Old hands will remember Bill as a very active member in the '70's and 80's. Bill came to the club from the ranks of the CBer's that flourished in the 1970's. The eleven metre DX skills he had developed were carried over to ten metres and honed to precision. In later years Bill's interests in radio moved into flying radio controlled model aircraft and eventually model trains. Bill's callsign was VK2KDI; "The mixed up kid" as he called himself. He will long be remembered as a quiet friendly voice that gave Amateur Radio that comfortable feeling of an extended family.
