
Tuesday-Net Report

### TUESDAY 26 APRIL, 2022

Another week rolls around so quickly, time for another Digi Net. Logging in with Paul VK2AMT under the club callsign of VK2SRC were: Duncan VK2DLR, Jeff VK2WSR, John VK2ZJJ, Nick VK2ZTY and Dave VK2ZDR. A good rollup, so after a couple of rounds on 2 metres Parrots Nest we QSY'd to ou now normal frequency of 7.046 MHz USB, for another go on Fldigi and Olivia 8-500.



Well, it was good to have a decent group joining in and welcome to Nick VK2ZTY. He said that he had a recent QSO with Switzerland using Olivia, that was very good to hear. The noise levels were a good deal higher than normal at my location. The frequency we use is usually around S7 at the beginning, increasing a bit to over S8 later on, tonight it was S9 +10 from the start and that didn't help with decoding. The decode percentages were patchy. I had problems with Jeff's signal but that was partly operator error on my part. I had the internal squelch on Fldigi turned on and that killed Jeff's signal. When I turned it off Jeff started to decode, but it was only about 25% readable. Others on the net had various degrees of success with decoding each other but, overall, it was a tough gig.

Another good net in spite of the conditions. It was good to have Nick on the net, the more the merrier. Thanks to all who toughed it out!!

# 6-DAY LISMORE (FORECAST). Click image to open METEYE (2480 for East Lismore).



RE: "Adding earth to ground."


Appears one instruction is missing, ADD WATER.
