We started off using the mode we used last week, Thor22. Jeff and Duncan were there on frequency and we started off. Dave VK2ZDR dropped in after a few overs. Thor22 is fine for fast touch typists but not for slow 2 fingered typists like most of us. This resulted in short overs. We switched over to Olivia 8-500, better for "conversation".

Another good net, I think that we all enjoyed the favourable conditions on 80 metres. Noise has been comfortably lower than everyone's signal strength, so decode has been excellent. Thanks to all who participated.
