TUESDAY 12 JULY, 2022

This evening we had John VK2ZJJ, Ross VK2ARD, Duncan VK2DLR and Dave VK2ZDR joining Paul VK2AMT as VK2SRC. We had our normal couple of rounds of chatter before Duncan and I QSY'd. We have been using 80 metres lately to give distant stations a chance to participate, but as it was only the two of us we used our old frequency of 144.230 USB.

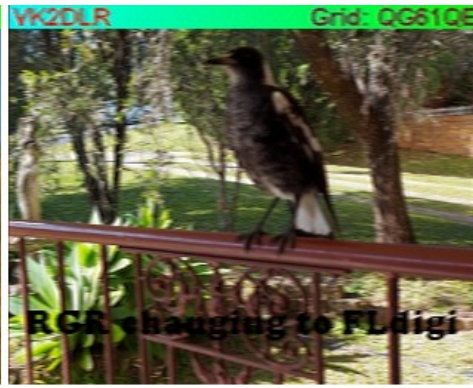
We started off using Fldigi for a few overs then switched to MMSSTV and Scottie2 mode. We both appreciated a nice clean, relatively noise free VHF path. HF (80 metres at present) will normally be used so anyone other than local operators can join in, that is always the first priority.



The images were particularly clean as you would expect, without the snow and noise bars that you get on HF. After we had exhausted our supply of images, we finished off back on Fldigi to finish the net off. Another good evening. It's annoying that it is just Duncan and I at times, but as long as someone is there to participate, the net will continue.
