
DIGITAL MODES

TUESDAY 9 AUGUST, 2022

Tonight, joining Paul VK2AMT as VK2SRC were: Duncan VK2DLR, Jeff VK2WSR, John VK2ZJJ, Chris VK2ACD and Dave VK2ZDR. We had our normal two rounds of chat on Parrots Nest 2 metres before Duncan and Chris joined me on 80 metres.

Jeff VK2WSR wasn't going to join in originally, planning to head for an early bed, but the lure of the Digi Net was too great and he joined in after a couple of rounds. We had to shift to 3.594 USB to avoid some voice traffic on 3.590. I used phone text messages to alert any operators needing any update on what we were doing. As usual, we used Fldigi and Olivia 8-500, the perfect mode for conversational keyboard traffic. It is slow enough to do edits and correct typos on the fly before the encoder catches you.



Most of the conversation centred around SARC Education in general, so it was really interesting and valuable. Chris and Jeff left us around 9.15 pm or so and Duncan and I continued until around 10pm. Science vs religion was one topic that we kicked around. Thanks to all who logged in and participated, it is really appreciated.
