
**Tuesday-Net Report**

## TUESDAY 30 AUGUST, 2022

Tonight, joining Paul VK2AMT as VK2SRC for the Digital Modes Net were Duncan VK2DLR, John VK2ZJJ, Jeff VK2WSR and Chris VK2ACD. As usual, we had our normal two rounds of chat on 2 metres (Woodburn this week) before we QSY'd to 80 metres.



Our normal frequency was 3.590 USB. I was joined there by Duncan, Jeff and Chris. We used Fldigi and Olivia 8-500. One reason for sticking with Olivia 8-500 that any comparison between Olivia and the other modes currently available in Fldigi simply shows up Olivia's superiority to all the others. Noisy conditions is where Olivia shines. We had noise of about S4-5 peaking at S9 or higher during static crashes. Not one character was lost to the noise. The Olivia signal just seems to be stronger

than the others. One good feature if the Digi Net is that it is virtually a replacement for the old Techie Net that we used to run. It gives everyone a chance to discuss technical matters.

Another good net, thanks to everyone who logged in and participated.
