

TUESDAY 11 OCTOBER, 2022

Tonight, joining Paul VK2AMT as VK2SRC were: Duncan VK2DLR, John VK2ZJJ, Chris VK2ACD, Jeff VK2WSR and Dave VK2ZDR. A pretty good rollup. As usual we had our couple of rounds of personal news and chat before Duncan, Jeff and Dave joined me on HF.



This evening we were trying 40 metres out, the frequency was 7.070 USB, Fldigi and Olivia 8-500. Most of us were at 40 watts. The VK3SRC signal from Joe was above us, on 7.071.5, using Olivia 8-250. I was hoping that we would not interfere with each other but the VK3SRC signal caused my copy of Fldigi to jump from Olivia 8-500 to 8-250 a few times. Nobody else had that problem, possibly because the signal wasn't as strong. I eventually experimented with the notch filter, shifting it until the signal weakened. You could see the effect of the notch filter on the waterfall, very cool! We will have to move around in frequency, as there are more signals towards the bottom of 40 metres than 80 metres. The decoding accuracy was 100%. There was quite a bit of discussion about the

progress on SARC Ed, not surprisingly. It was good to see that everyone could make 40 metres work, showing that the band will be a very useful band for the Digi Net in the months ahead if 80 metres is too noisy.

Another good net, thanks to all who logged in and participated.


