#### TUESDAY 25 OCTOBER, 2022

Tonight, Paul VK2AMT, using the club callsign of VK2SRC was joined by: Duncan VK2DLR, John VK2ZJJ and Jeff VK2WSR. We were joined on 40 metres by Phil VK2YGF and Dave VK2ZDR. We had our normal two rounds of personal news and chat before we QSY'd to our 40 metre frequency, 7.035 USB.

We used Fldigi and Olivia 8-500, as usual. The noise at my QTH was S5 and this increased to S6 later on. Phil VK2YGF joined us for a few short overs, using a Yaesu FT707, the signal was accompanied by a fairly healthy buzz but that didn't affect the decoding accuracy, that was 100% to everyone. Dave VK2ZDR also dropped in. Dave remonstrated with us about leaving a gap, quite correctly. I will try to remember to do that and type in a message to any stations wishing to join the net, to drop in with callsign and first name, and leave enough of a gap between overs for any visitor to drop in. This enables net control to add any new station to the transmit list.

Another good session, the overall noise level was high but everyone's signal was comfortably above that and decode didn't suffer at all. Thanks to all who logged in and participated. I reiterate, visitors are welcome to the Digi Net, it is not just restricted to club members alone. Drop in, you will be made most welcome





# 6-DAY LISMORE (FORECAST). Click image to open METEYE (2480 for East Lismore).
