For this evening's Diginet, Paul VK2AMT, using the club's callsign of VK2SRC logged in: Duncan VK2DLR, Chris VK2ACD, Jeff VK2WSR and John VK2ZJJ. We had our normal couple of overs of personal news, what we did that day, before Duncan and Jeff joined me on 7.035 USB.

As usual, we used Fldigi and Olivia 8-500. The discussion was quite varied. Noise was about normal (S5 here) and increased about one S point over the next hour or so, which it usually does. Decode was fine from everyone. Jeff was using the gear at the clubrooms via remote control, requiring some

“soft shoe shuffle” at the controls. We had a visit from Phil VK2YGF at a bit after 9pm for a couple of overs. We wanted to know if the healthy buzz on his audio on last week’s Dignet was gone, it was, the signal was clean.

We were careful to leave a 15 second gap between overs to allow time for visitors to drop in with callsign and first name. Another good net with excellent discussion. Thanks to all who logged in and participated. It is appreciated as it keeps the net going.

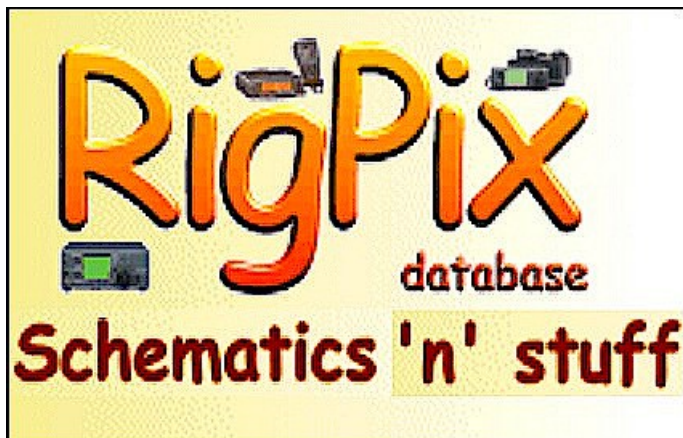
