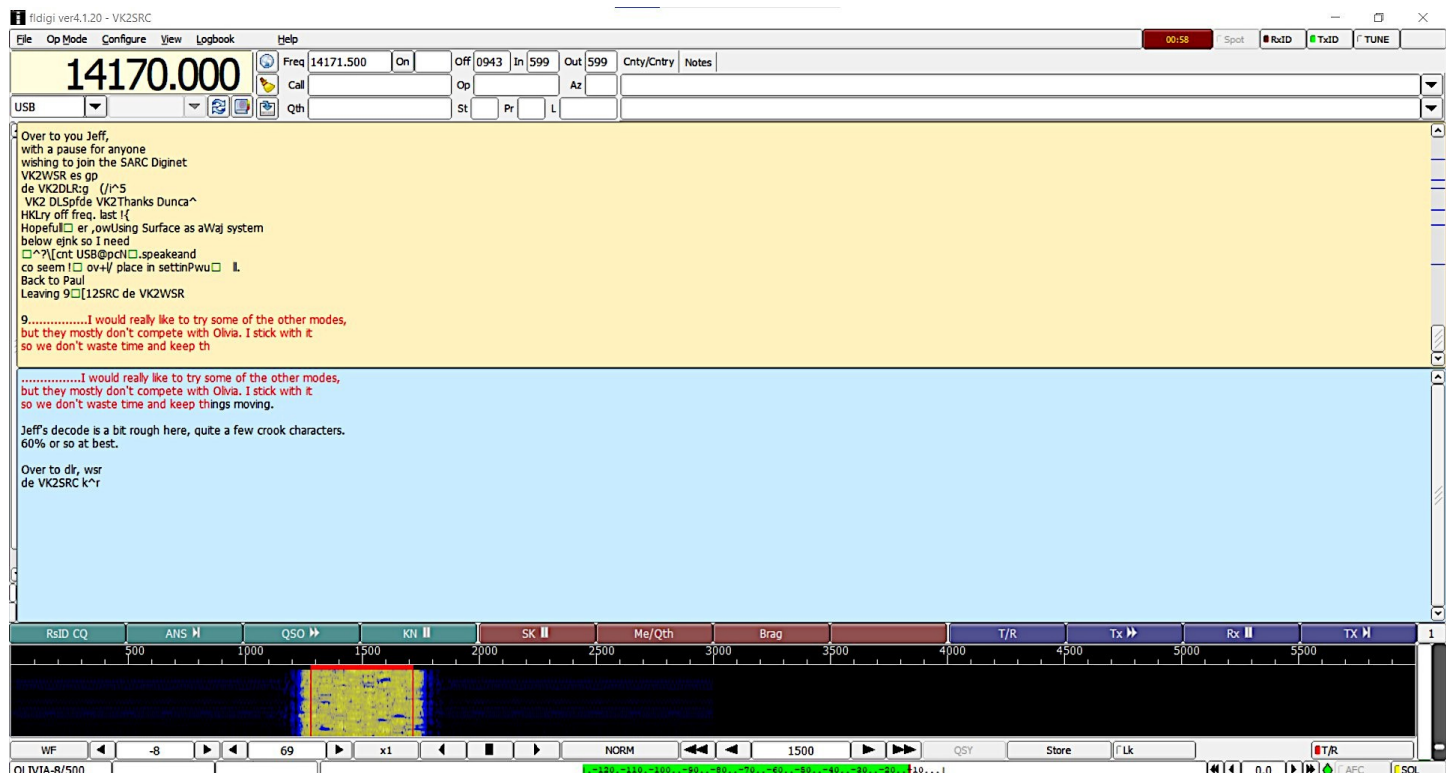
## Tuesday-Net Report

## DIGI NET

- Paul VK2AMT

TUESDAY 29 NOVEMBER, 2022

This evening, Paul VK2AMT as VK2SRC logged in: Duncan VK2DLR, Jeff VK2WSR, John VK2ZJJ and Chris VK2ACD for the Digi Net. We had our normal couple of rounds on Woodburn 2 metres before Duncan and Jeff joined me on 40 metres.



We used Fldigi and DominoEx22, just for an experiment. There had been some CW on our normal frequency so we went to 7.045 USB. Domino EX didn't cope as well with the S8 noise at my location as Olivia. Jeff's signal decode accuracy was well below 50%, so we switched back to Olivia after a

couple of overs. Later on, I asked Jeff to check the club 7300's power setting due to poorer than expected decode from Jeff on Olivia. The club 7300 was set on about 5 watts, due to its use during the Foundation course practical exams. Once the power was increased to about 40 watts, the decoding accuracy went up to 100%. Maybe DominoEx isn't quite as good as Olivia – basically, nothing else in Fldigi matches it.

Another good net. Duncan mentioned the file transfer protocol of Flarq as a future experiment. It has been quite some time since we last used that program, which works through Fldigi using a mode such as Thor 22 rather than Olivia. I think that some homework would be needed before dusting that mode off! Thanks to Duncan and Jeff for their support.

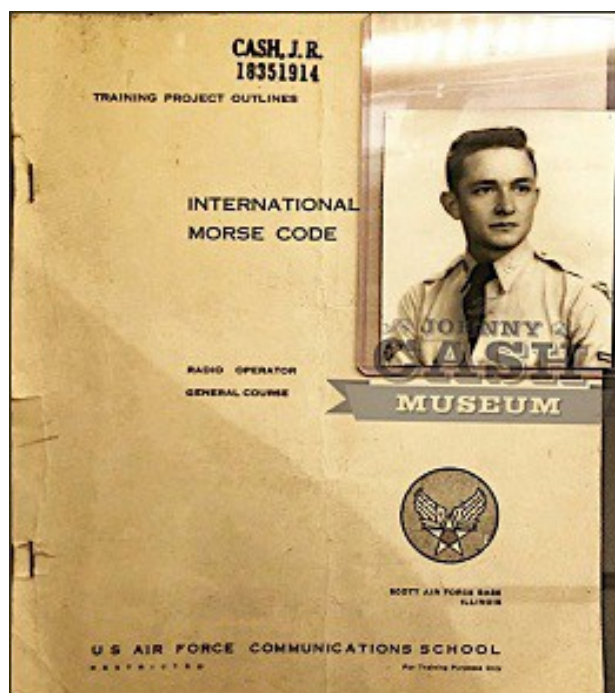

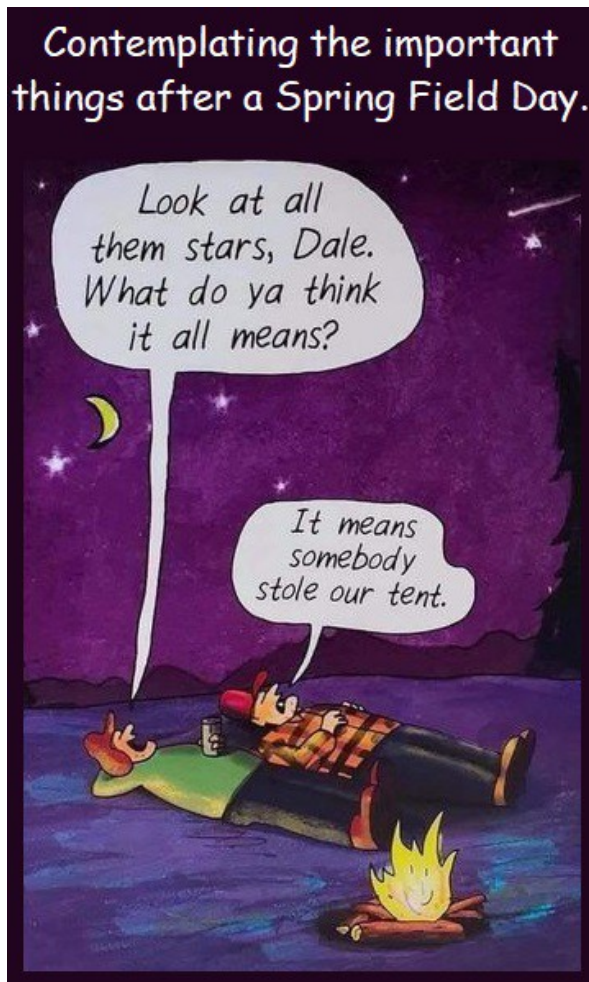


## DID YOU KNOW

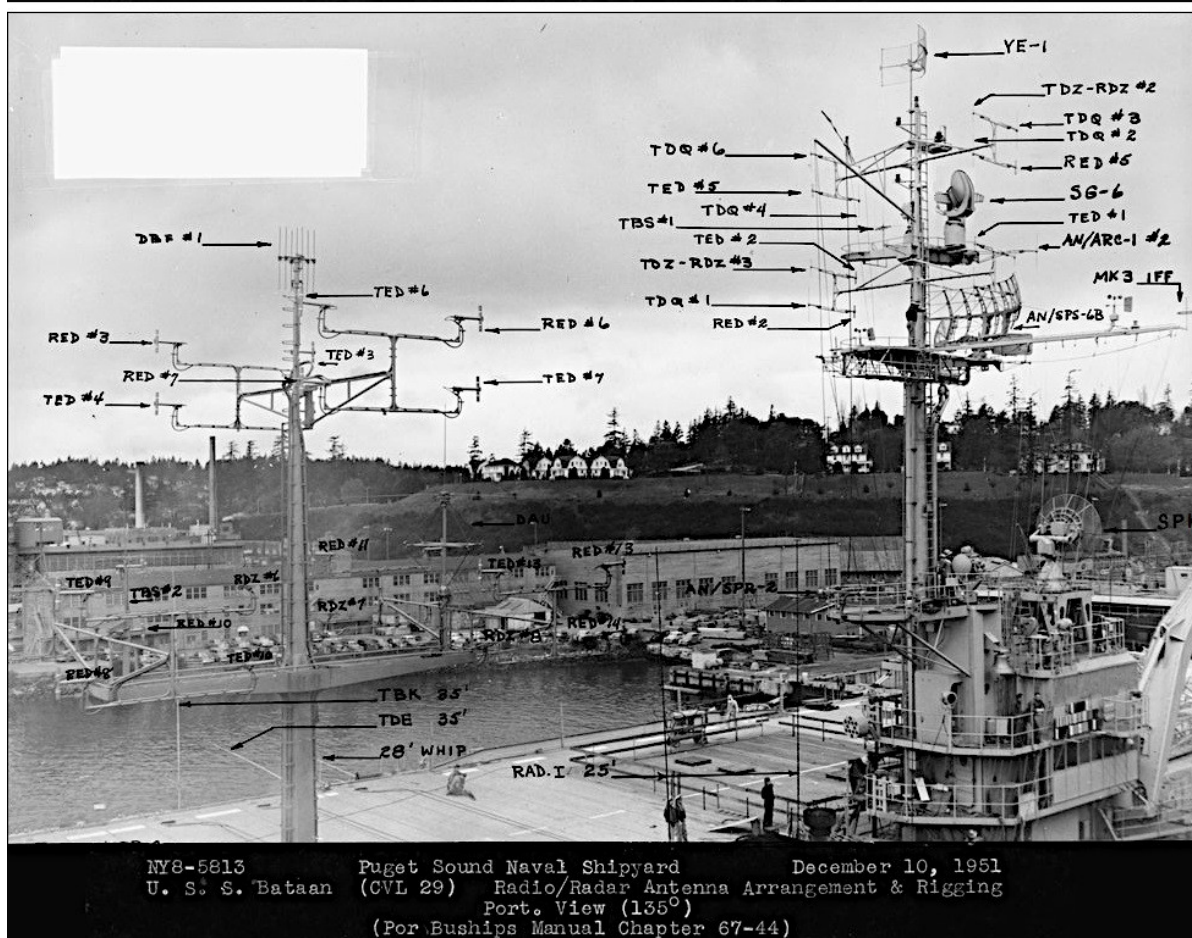
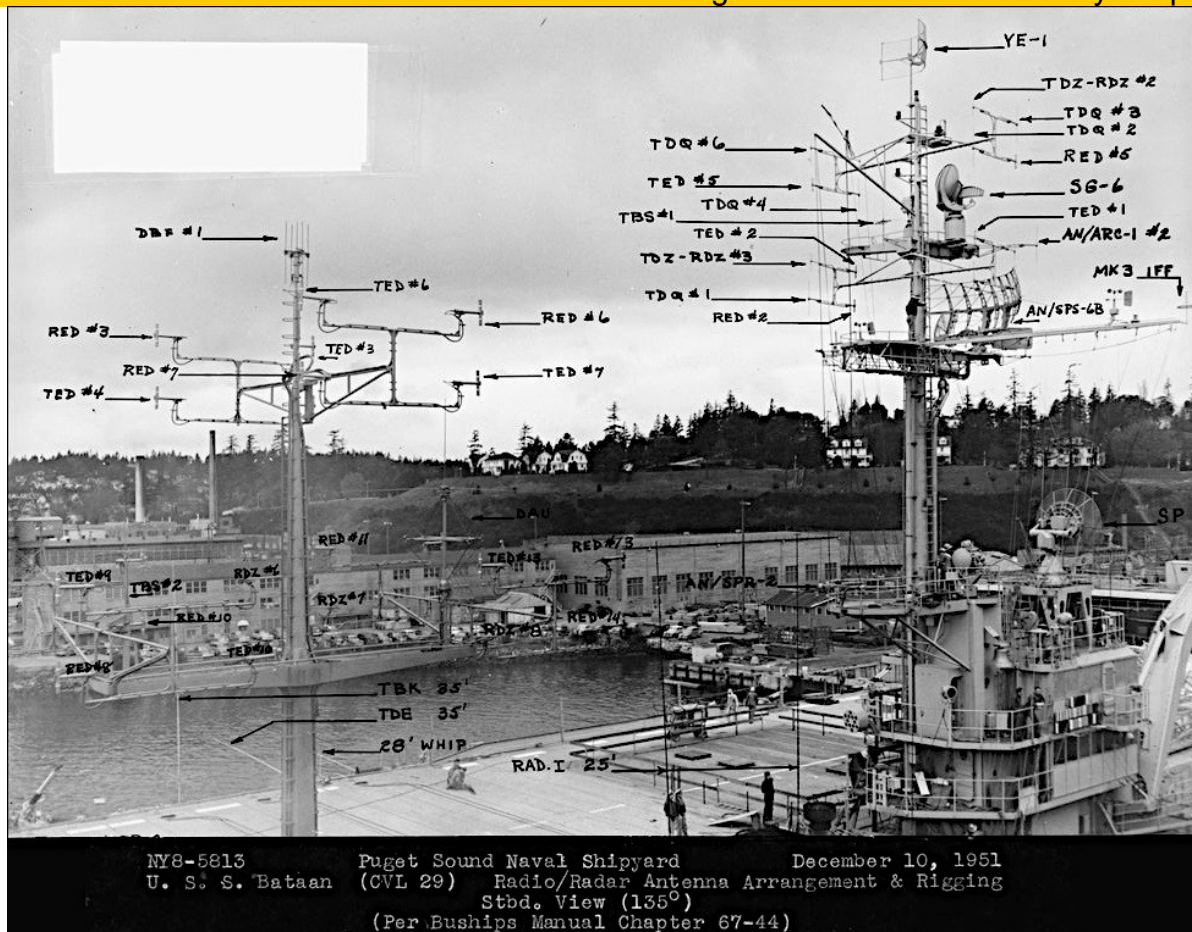
