Tuesday-Net Report

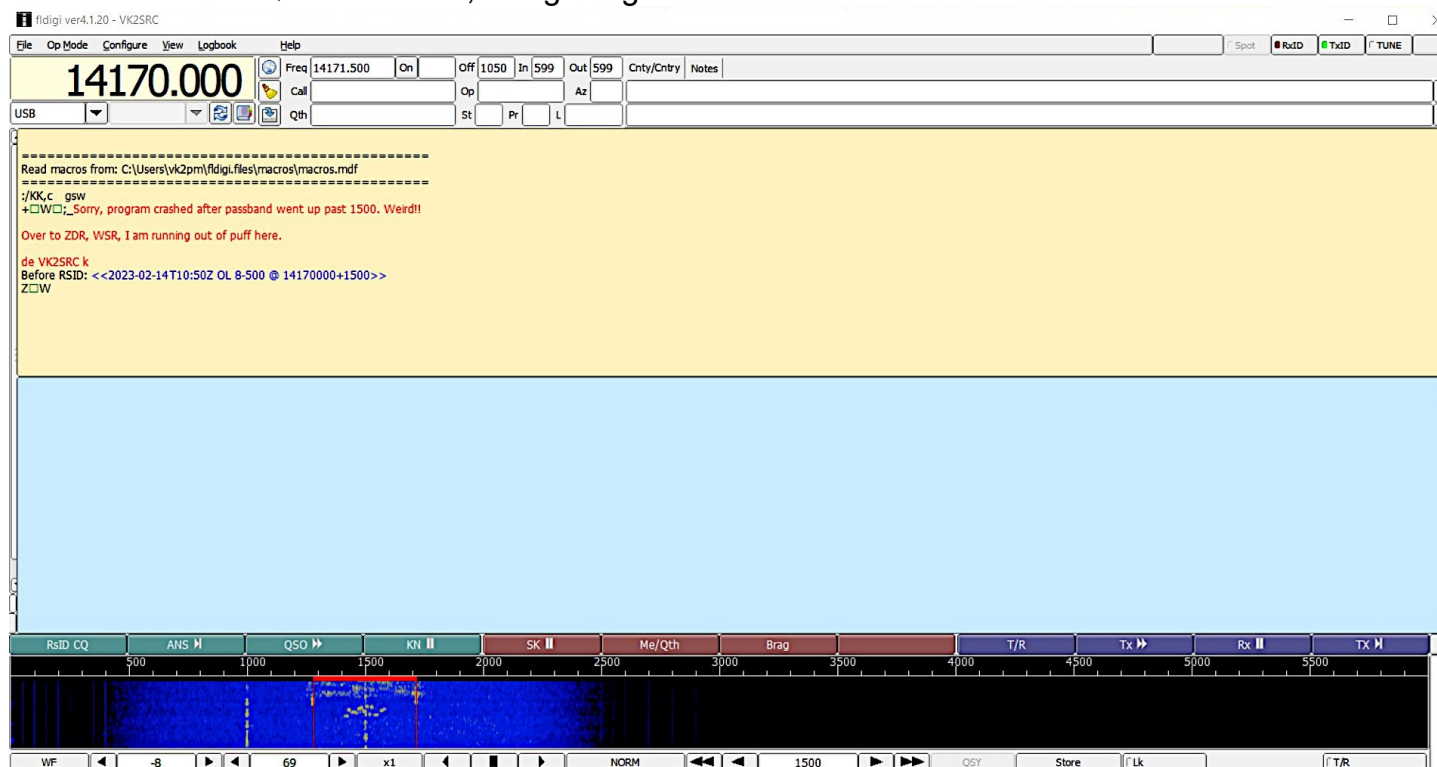
DIGITAL MODES

- Paul VK2AMT

TUESDAY 14 FEBRUARY, 2023

Main topic was Lithium batteries and the effect on insurance.

Tonight, Paul VK2AMT, using the club callsign of VK2SRC was joined by: Duncan VK2DLR, John VK2ZJJ, Chris VK2ACD and Shaun VK2DSL. Jeff VK2WSR was waiting on our frequency of 7.035 USB. Chris and I QSY'd to there, using Fldigi and Olivia 8-500.



This was a net of comings and goings. Chris stayed for quite a few overs but had to leave to do other things. Jeff was decoding us but the remote TX didn't work until about 9.15pm. It was somewhat

broken up so decoding accuracy was lucky to be 40%, but better than nothing. Scott VK1PWE from Canberra dropped in at 9.03pm but only for a couple of brief overs. Dave VK2ZDR also dropped in at about that time and stayed until the net finished at 10pm. We may have to find another frequency as there were 2 CW operators, one was at 1000 Hz, just below our Olivia passband. The other one was at 1500Hz, right in the middle of our signals. The dotted traces can be seen on the photo accompanying this report. Olivia just ignored the CW signal but maybe we interfered with them!!! We will have to find another frequency between 7.040 and 7.060 (the digital modes section) and hope that the voice TX stations keep away.

Another good net, thanks as always to all who logged in and participated. It is worth repeating that although it is a SARC Club Net, visitors are always welcome.

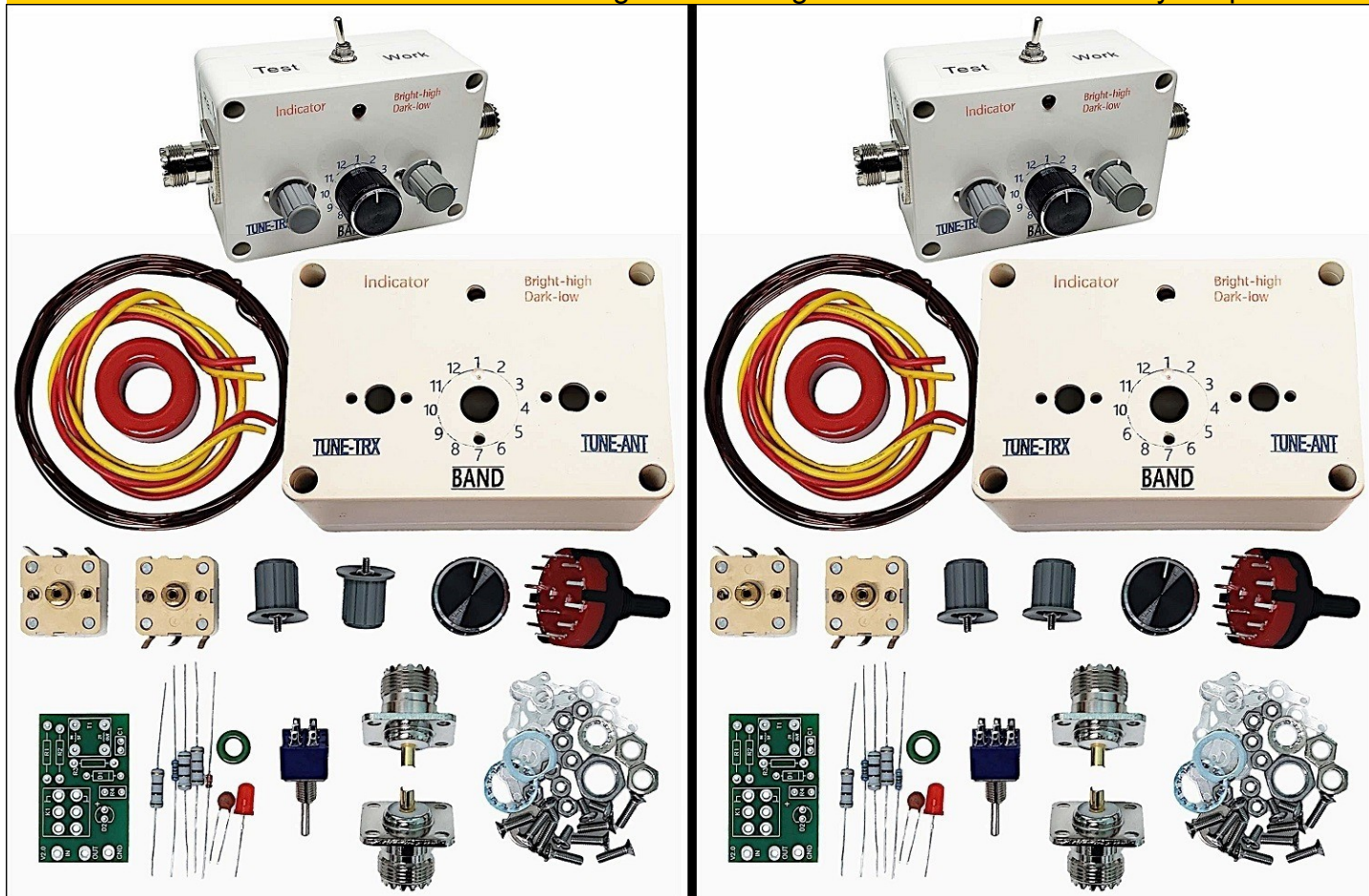
