TUESDAY 7 MARCH, 2023

This evening, Paul VK2AMT as VK2SRC, logged in: Duncan VK2DLR, John VK2ZJJ, Jeff VK2WSR and Dave VK2ZDR. We heard later on that Shane VK2HAZ was decoding us. We had our normal couple of rounds on Woodburn's 2 metre repeater before Duncan, Jeff and I QSY'd to our normal frequency of 7.048 USB for another session with Fldigi's Olivia 8-500.

We didn't get off to a very good start, I started off frequency due to a bumped VFO and Duncan had computer problems and swapped over to another one. Jeff was decoding us for a while but didn't transmit due to a high SWR reading on the club 7300. The Fritzel FD3 antenna I started off with wasn't receiving very well, so I went back to the Hustler vertical. Perhaps a vertical antenna trying to

work stations with horizontal dipoles on ground wave isn't the best. The vertical's transmit was fine, the receive not so good.

Finally, Duncan and I got sorted and had a good session. The S/N ratio varied hugely. Duncan was about -8 S/N. Dave VK2ZDR dropped in at 9.20pm. Another case of "better late than never". Dave's signal was excellent as always. Another good net that had a rough start, but we made it work with some persistence. The image with the report show's Duncan's almost invisible signal on the waterfall but Olivia still decoded it! Thanks to all who participated.

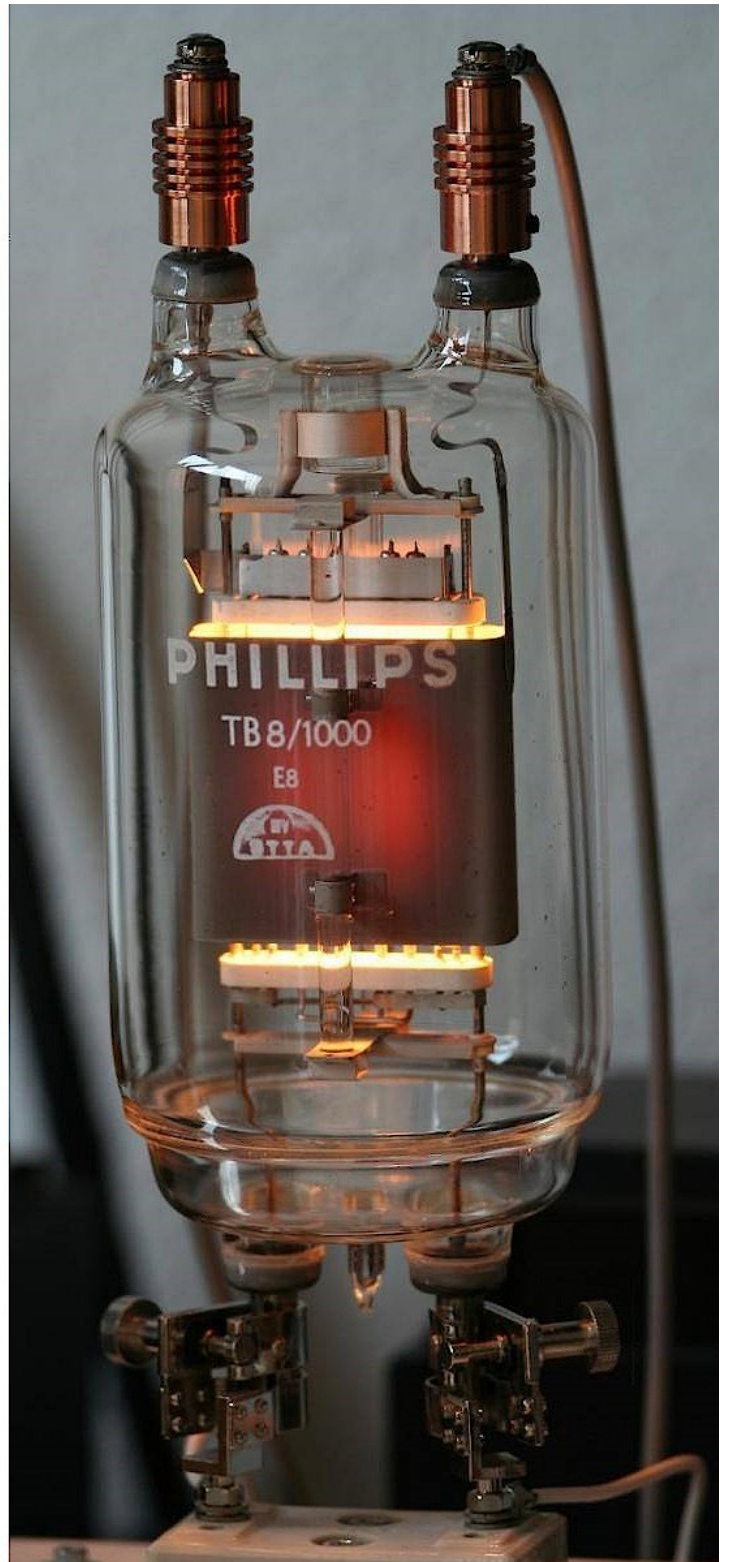
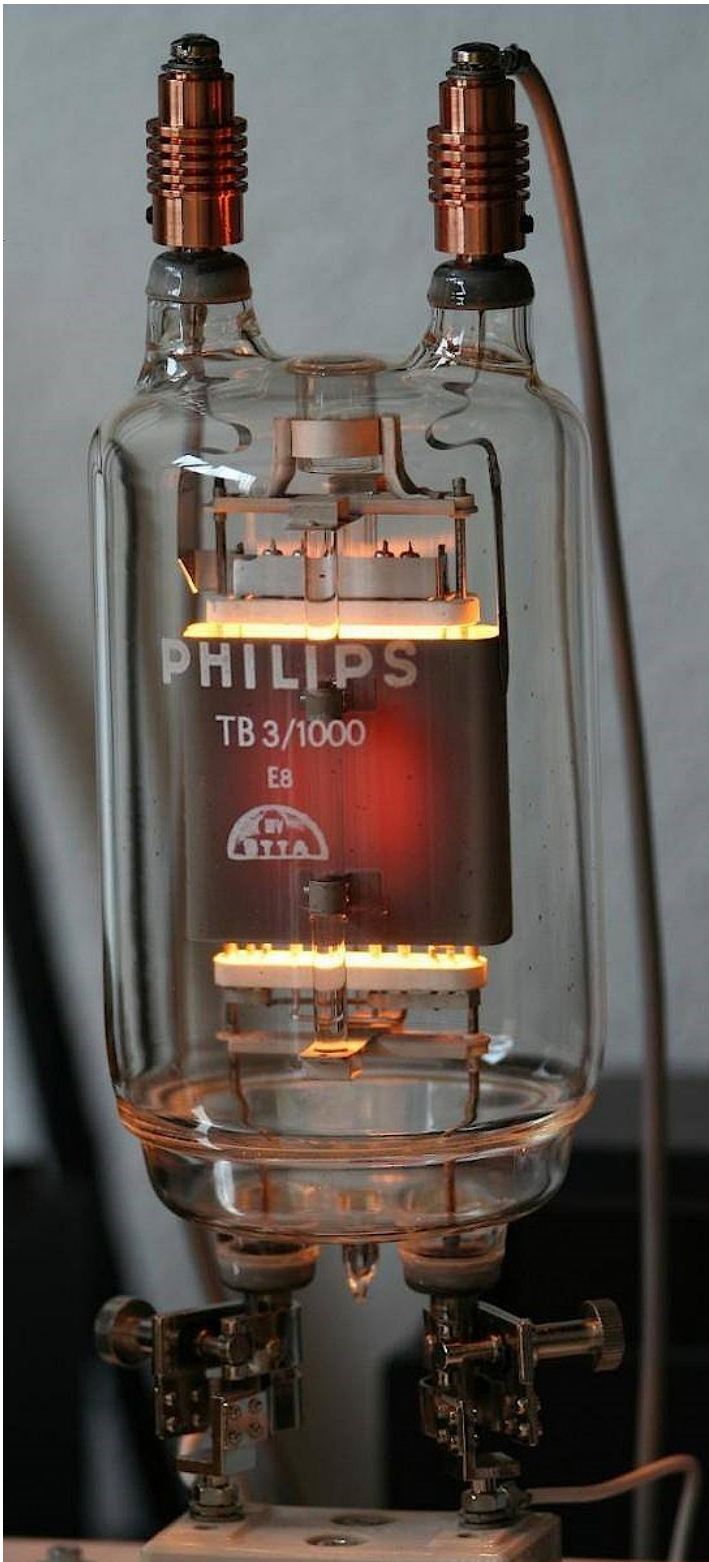
