#### **TUESDAY 30 MAY. 2023**

Tonight, logging in on the Diginet were: John VK2ZJJ, Duncan VK2DLR, Jeff VK2WSR, Chris VK2ACD and Dave VK2ZDR. That was a pretty good rollup. As always, we had two rounds of personal news and chat before Duncan and Jeff joined me on 7.048 USB.

We used Fldigi and Olivia 8-500. Andrew VK2XI was trying to decode us. He had huge QRM at his location. Both Duncan and I had trouble decoding Jeff. Only a few scattered half words made it. There was apparently a SWR issue at the clubrooms and that wouldn't have helped. After a few overs we decided to QSY to 2 metres, 144.230 USB.

We all welcomed the huge difference using 2 metres made. The difficulties of 40 metres' ground wave signals are really annoying, especially since only a few kilometres separate the club station, Duncan and I. Andrew decoded Jeff and I at the start on 2 metres but not Duncan who was only using 10 watts and his takeoff to the north isn't very good, so that may have explained it. The good times didn't last as dropouts and glitches on Jeff's signal caused him to drop off the transmit and listen and decode for a while.

Well, we made the best of the conditions and technical problems and just persevered. Thanks to Duncan and Jeff for their continued support.

# Those who came before us - Trevor Thompson (VK4ZTT) SK - Duncan VK2DLR

### A Bit of Morse Code Trivia



On the latest episode of 'Hard Quiz' on ABC TV, the winner of the big brass mug was a fellow with the special subject of Morse code.


