We continued trying 80 metres, using Fldigi and Olivia 8-500 as usual. Band conditions were pretty good, apart from the S9 noise that Duncan and I have had. Jeff's local noise was somewhat less. There wasn't as much fading this week, so decoding was 100% all night, as it has been since we switched to 80 metres.
