
DIGITAL MODES

TUESDAY 24 OCTOBER, 2023

Here's another Diginet report, with screenshot this time.

For this week's Diginet, Paul VK2AMT as VK2SRC was joined by Duncan VK2DLR and John VK2ZJJ. We had our normal couple of rounds of personal news and chat before we QSY'd to our normal 80 metre frequency of 3.590 USB.



As usual, we used Fldigi and Olivia 8-500. Jeff was there on frequency, using his new callsign of VK2NU. Band conditions were very similar to previous weeks. Noise at my place was only S2 but that could mainly be due to the antenna. The noise goes from S2 to S9 when the Preamp 1 is turned on,

so I now leave it off. Noise reduction has been rather reluctantly used at a moderate level to help with decoding accuracy. Duncan was S4-5 and S/N about +14. Jeff was S2-S3 and +2 to +7. Decoding was 100%. Dave VK2ZDR dropped in at 9.09pm and he was S6-7 and +17. Part of the discussion revolved around SOTA setups and the rules involved. Jeff disappeared for a short while when Fldigi went to sleep but was soon back after a restart.

Another enjoyable net with the excellent conversation we always have. Thanks to Duncan, Jeff and Dave for their support.



Dawn Patrol Net Report
