

This evening, Paul VK2AMT as VK2SRC logged in Jo VK2ZJJ. We had our normal couple of overs on 2 metres Parrots Nest before I QSY'd to 40 metres, 7.050, USB. Jeff was waiting there for me. We used Fldigi and Olivia 8-500. The noise on the vertical antenna here was S3 and Jeff was comfortably above that, S4-5 and the S/N ratio was about +3.



The signals on 40 metres were good, and remained so. There was no appreciable amount of QSB, Jeff was using the Icom 7300, hurriedly prepared for the Diginet after Jeff's Kenwood TS2000 was affected by a lightning strike. One main topic of the net was gathering information about the popular weak signal mode FT8, which Jeff was keen to try.

I had been using FT8 ever since it was introduced in 2017, so I was pleased to see Jeff have a go. We decided to use Zoom to gather hints and advice on the mode. It was another good evening that featured keyboard conversation that was mainly technical in nature. Thanks to Jo for logging in and thanks Jeff for getting the Icom 7300 ready for the net.

We'd hate to see the conversation get stuck in a rut so why not add your topic to the discussions on Friday nights at 8pm VK2 time, 7pm in VK4?




